

IEP and ISP Process: State Assessments and Other Participations	Reorder fields on State Assessments page and add 3 rd option for State Testing choice	The system now displays the school accreditation prompt before the student assessment testing prompt. A third option has been added to the State Testing option Dropdown "Student is not yet in grade 3".	User should complete the School Accreditation and the State Testing dropdown selections appropriately.
IEP/ISP Process: Goals	Addition of a "Copy Goal" button on the Goal Details page	<p>For each new or existing goal, the user may opt to copy the goal. The copy will appear at the bottom of the list on the Goals page. The copy of an existing goal will be editable.</p> <p>It is important to note, Indiana IEP treats a copy of an existing goal as a brand new goal. The copy will be an individual goal in the Progress Monitoring Wizard.</p>	<p>To make a copy, open an existing goal. At the top of the Goal Details page the Copy Goal button will be displayed. Click this button. The system will copy the goal and display a pop up indicating the goal was successfully copied and where it may be found for editing.</p> <p>The system will also display the page errors if required fields for the current goal are not completed.</p>
IEP process: Create IEP page	Date field for start of 10-day auto accept timeline	A mandatory date field has been created to log the date parents received the proposed IEP document; 10 days after this date, the system will automatically accept the proposed IEP.	When creating the IEP, users must enter the date the parents received the Proposed IEP document
IEP Process: Create IEP page	Parent Survey Reminder	A pop-up box provides a link to the annual parent survey and reminds the user that the parent or guardian should complete the survey after the annual case conference is complete	Users can click on the link during the case conference to have the parents/guardians complete the survey, or send the link to the parents
IEP/ISP Process	Proposed Initiation and Annual Review dates	<p>All "IEP/ISP begin dates" or "service/goal Start Dates" will be relabeled in the system to "Proposed Initiation Date".</p> <p>All "IEP/ISP end dates" or "service/goal End Date" labels will be relabeled "Annual Review Date". Advanced Reporting fields will also be relabeled.</p>	No Change to users' actions.

<p>Evaluation Process: Multi-disciplinary (MD) Team List</p>	<p>Assign Multi-disciplinary (MD) Team Roles</p>	<p>Allow users to add additional members to the MD Team beyond current requirements. In some cases members need to be added to a team that are not required.</p>	<p>Users may now add all participating Evaluation Team members to the MD Team list using the "Additional Name" option and these MD Team members will appear on the Assessment Data page and report.</p>
<p>ISP Process: Meeting Purpose Page</p>	<p>Added Info Box regarding Reevaluation Referral; User must complete IEP Process - Reevaluation Review</p>	<p>If Reevaluation Review is the selected purpose in Pre conference planning and the student is Privately Placed with an accepted ISP, an information box will appear to advise the end user to complete the IEP process and offer services to the parent.</p>	<p>Users must complete the IEP process and offer services to the parent. The IEP Process will prompt the need for rejection of FAPE before an Annual or Revise ISP can be completed.</p>
<p>IEP Process: Meeting Purpose Page</p>	<p>Move-in Independent from Pre-Conference & IEP Process</p>	<p>When Move-in is selected in Pre-Conference Planning – Type of Evaluation or in the IEP Process – Meeting Purpose, the selection of Move-in will no longer be automatically selected in the other.</p>	<p>Users will need to ensure that the meeting purpose is appropriately manually selected in both Pre-Conference Planning and the IEP Process.</p>
<p>Meeting Planning, Schedule CCC</p>	<p>Schedule CCC Partial Excusal</p>	<p>Attendee that was excused by parent permission for a portion of the CCC will now appear with the CCC Meeting attendees on the Create IEP page.</p>	<p>Users should ensure that any attendees that were excused for a portion of the meeting are listed and confirmed as attendees.</p>
